Primary Duties and Responsibilities

The Assistant Chief of Fires supports the Chief of Fires in their primary tasks of synchronizing and coordinating joint all domain fire support. Their responsibilities typically include:

- Planning, preparing, executing, and assessing all fires tasks in support of offensive, defensive and stability tasks and providing inputs for preparation of the OPLAN and OPORD.
- Developing, with the commander and G-3, a scheme of fires to support the operation.
- Planning and coordinating fire support tasks.
- Developing a proposed high-payoff target list, target selection standards, and attack guidance matrix.
- Identifying named and target areas of interest, high-payoff targets, support the development of high-payoff target list and attack guidance matrix and additional events that may influence the positioning of fire support assets.

They often oversee the day-to-day operations of the fires cell, which is the staff section responsible for planning and coordinating fire support. This includes managing the personnel and resources within the cell.
