Primary Duties and Responsibilities

The Deputy Air and Missile Defense (AMD) Chief is responsible for advising and coordinating air and missile defense activities and plans with the AMD Chief. The air and missile defense officer supports the protection warfighting function, integrates the planning and use of all joint all domains air and missile defense systems, assets, and operations.

The air and missile defense officer is coordinated by the G-3. This officer prepares Appendix 7 (Air and Missile Defense) of Annex D (Fires) to the OPORD or OPLAN. The air and missile defense officer responsibilities include, but are not limited to—

- Disseminating air tasking order and airspace control order information to air defense artillery units.
- Integrating airspace coordinating measures to support air and missile defense operations.
- Recommending active and passive air defense measures.
- Determining requirements and recommending assets to support air and missile defense.
- Providing information on the status of air and missile defense systems, air and missile attack early warning radars, and air defense artillery ammunition
